

## **WHATS ON FOR...**

### **Babies, Children & Young People**

All of the activities listed below are drop-in groups and do not require you to book. They run term time only although there may be additional holiday activity which will be advertised at the time. The only exception to this is Lowther After School Club (please see booking details below)

#### **PLAYGROUP**

Drop in playgroup for 0 – 5 year olds and their carers.

Both free play and structured activities.

Children aged 2 and a half upwards may be left unattended at a cost of £3.50 per session.
